



DE-ESCALATION TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

The Training

Crisis Response Programs and Training (CRPT) offers **De-escalation Training for Law Enforcement**, an 8-hour course focused on ensuring safety in a variety of calls. The course includes:

- Signs, symptoms, and presentations of psychiatric disorders, developmental disorders, age-related disorders, cognitive disorders, and substance abuse disorders,
- Specially developed training videos,
- Techniques to respond safely and calmly,
- Scenarios based on real calls for service, and
- Appropriate and sustainable dispositions to crisis calls for service.

Each attendee will receive a manual and a certificate of attendance.

A 4-hour version of the course, **De-escalation Training for Law Enforcement – Intervention Strategies** is also available and omits the clinical portion of the 8-hour course for those officers well-trained in behavioral health issues.

The Train-the-Trainer

CRPT also offers a **3-day in-person train-the-trainer** of this popular De-escalation Training for Law Enforcement course. Upon successfully completing the program, instructors will have access to all training materials and maintain access to all updates as long as they maintain an instructor membership in CRPT.
